Seldom-performed repertoire for two harps will be in the spotlight when the **Salzedo Harp Duo** performs in Hudson.

On Sunday, November 16<sup>th</sup>, **Music from the Western Reserve** continues its 7th season at Hudson's Western Reserve Academy with a performance by two virtuoso harpists, Nancy Lendrim and Jody Guinn.

Both are noted members of area orchestras. Ms. Lendrim holds the principal harp chair in the Toledo Symphony, and Ms. Guinn is principal for the Akron Symphony Orchestra. Both also studied with Alice Chalifoux, harpist of The Cleveland Orchestra from 1931 to 1974, and protégé and successor to the noted harp proponent Carlos Salzedo. Their research has uncovered unpublished music for two harps by Salzedo, works which are now in their repertoire.

Nancy Lendrim is a graduate of the Cleveland Institute of Music and the Oberlin Conservatory. She has performed with The Cleveland Orchestra and the orchestras of Philadelphia and Atlanta. Ms. Lendrim is a member of the faculty at the University of Toledo, Heidelberg College, and the Saratoga Harp Colony. Her recordings are available on the Azica and Decca labels.

Jody Guinn studied at the Cleveland Institute of Music. She has appeared with the orchestras of Cincinnati, Philadelphia, and Baltimore. With The Cleveland Orchestra, she has recorded and toured, and currently is second harp. Ms Guinn has been principal harp of the Akron Symphony Orchestra and the Opera Cleveland Orchestra for almost a quarter century. She teaches at Baldwin-Wallace Conservatory and at Pennsylvania's Westminster College

The Western Reserve Academy concert by the **Salzedo Harp Duo** begins at 5:00pm in the Academy's historic chapel. Tickets are \$15 for adults, and \$5 for students.
